

FY2014/FY2015 INITIATIVES STATUS Department of Motor Vehicles

INITATIVE 1: Redesign credential and implement central issuance.

To deter fraud and implement industry best practice solutions, DC DMV will move to a central issuance process and redesign our credentials to include enhanced security features.

Status: Effective November 26, 2013, DC DMV moved to a central issuance process. Driver licenses and identification cards are mailed to customers, and they are no longer issued over the counter. Customers are issued a temporary paper license or identification card valid for 45 days, and the new credential is mailed. Additionally, the driver license and identification card have been redesigned, a motor vehicle industry best practice, to reduce fraud. Approximately \$1.2M in funds was used for implementation.

INITIATIVE 2: Modify the medical referral process.

DMV will standardize the current medical review process. Specifically, DMV will create a form for use by medical doctors, law enforcement and/or family members to refer customers whom they deem are no longer able to safely operate a motor vehicle. In addition, the DMV will create a brochure to explain options available to those who are no longer eligible to drive due to age or medical reasons.

Status: By February 2014, DC DMV enhanced the medical review process and developed an online form for reporting customers who may no longer be able to safely operate a motor vehicle. Funding was \$0.00.

INITIATIVE 3: Review bankruptcy requirements.

DMV receives daily notifications from federal bankruptcy courts of bankruptcy petitions filed listing DMV as a creditor for unpaid tickets. Bankruptcy laws provide that DMV must cease all enforcement and collection efforts while the bankruptcy is pending; however, parking and traffic tickets owed to a municipality are not forgiven upon discharge of the bankruptcy. The petitioner may still be responsible for the tickets after discharge. The treatment of tickets depends on whether the bankruptcy is filed under Chapter 7, 11 or 13. DMV will review the bankruptcy requirements and re-engineer its ticket processing procedures to ensure compliance with any changes to bankruptcy laws and applicable DC traffic laws and regulations.

Status: By March 2014, DC DMV coordinated with the Office of the Attorney General to modify the ticket database and reporting system to ensure DC DMV complied with all requirements of Chapter 7 and 13 bankruptcy filings. The process was enhanced to introduce additional automation into the process after the discharge of bankruptcies. Funding was \$0.00.

INITIATIVE 4: Conduct DPW/DMV/DDOT live parking web chat.

DMV will partner with DPW and DDOT to host a live web chat to answer parking related questions from District residents and visitors. Since parking issues cross over the three agencies, it is beneficial to periodically conduct joint events to address customer concerns.

Status: On March 10, 2014, DMV, DPW and DDOT held a live web chat to address parking issues related to the various agencies. Funding was \$0.00.

INITIATIVE 5: Implement The Parent's Supervised Driving Program.

DMV will partner with Safe Roads Alliance, a non-profit organization dedicated to improving highway safety by improving driver education, to implement their program geared towards ensuring parents provide supervised driving to their teens. The program will enhance the District's mandated 40 hour supervision requirement and reinforce safety requirements using a methodical teaching tool for parents and instructional tool for teens.

Status: In March 2014, the Parent's Supervised Driving Program and manual were successfully implemented in coordination with Safe Roads Alliance. Funding was \$0.00.

INITIATIVE 6: Open a Fourth DMV Service Center.

In an effort to better serve the citizens of the District, DC DMV will open a fourth service center location in Northwest Washington in Georgetown. This initiative will increase customer satisfaction and will provide additional capacity to process increased DC population and undocumented residents.

Status: The new Georgetown Service Center was opened to the public on April 29, 2014. Approximately \$2.6M in funding was used for staffing and facility costs.

INITIATIVE 7: Implement the issuance of driver licenses and identification cards to undocumented residents.

This initiative, which requires legislation currently before the DC Council, will allow for the issuance of a driver license, permit or identification card to undocumented residents. This initiative directly relates to the safety of all residents because it ensures those driving on the District's roadways have been properly tested, for both driving knowledge and driving skills.

Status: On May 1, 2014, DC DMV successfully implemented the issuance of credentials for undocumented residents (i.e., Limited Purpose credentials) in accordance with the Driver Safety Amendment Act of 2013. Approximately \$727,000 in funds was used for implementation.



INITIATIVE 8: Re-engineer the Registration of Out-of-State Automobiles (ROSA) program.

Currently, overnight out-of-state visitors in residential parking areas may receive tickets for "failure to obtain DC tags" in an effort to ensure new District residents timely title and register their vehicles in the District. The current process for issuing ROSA exemptions to out-of-state residents is not customer-focused. Therefore, DMV will reengineer the ROSA program with corresponding legislation. The program would streamline the process of obtaining a ROSA by allowing requests to be submitted online.

Status: An online process for allowing customers to request ROSA exemptions was implemented on August 30, 2014. Funding was \$0.00.

INITIATIVE 9: Online reciprocity renewal.

DMV will investigate the feasibility of allowing customers to scan and upload the documents required to renew their reciprocity permit online. This initiative will streamline DMV operations and provide customers with alternate renewal options.

Status: By August 2014, DC DMV implemented an online process that allows customers to renew their reciprocity. Funding was \$0.00.

INITIATIVE 10: Offer free Wi-Fi in all DMV locations.

DMV will implement the necessary technology to offer free Wi-Fi connection in all DMV locations. This will allow customers to occupy their time while waiting for DMV services.

Status: In September 2014, free Wi-Fi was implemented in all DC DMV locations, except the CDL Road Test Lot for which Wi-Fi implementation was not feasible. Funding was absorbed in our telecom budget.

INITITIVE 11: Train frontline service center employees on customer service techniques.

In an effort to better serve the citizens of the District, the DMV will train 90% of frontline service center employees on customer service techniques. In FY13, DMV's customer service training focused on active listening and in FY14 the training will increase customer service by refreshing employees on how to project a positive attitude and de-escalate situations. Enhanced customer service skills will lead to better interactions during the first contact with a customer.

Status: By September 2014, 96% of all frontline employees completed customer service training. Funding was \$0.00 because our in-house trainer was used.

INITIATIVE 12: Educate public about DC DMV driver records.

Develop information brochure and video to educate the public, specifically District residents, about the different portions of DC driver records. Since all jurisdictions' driver



records are formatted differently, residents are often confused in regards to how to interpret their driver records.

Status: By September 2014, DC DMV created an electronic brochure and a video which goes through each portion of the DC driver record and explains it to customers. This initiative was funded with \$21,500 from a District Department of Transportation grant.

INITIATIVE 13: Implement Adjudication Reconsideration Process.

To comply with the Traffic Adjudication Amendment Act of 2013, DMV will significantly modify the adjudication process to allow customers to request reconsideration within thirty days after a liable hearing decision and prior to the appeals process. Additionally, in limited circumstances, customers will be able to submit a ticket for a hearing within 365 days of the ticket issuance date.

Status: On October 1, 2014, DMV implemented the basic requirements of the Act which has resulted in a decrease of appeal requests since customers can submit additional or new evidence with their reconsideration request. Existing vendor funds were used.

INITIATIVE 14: Conduct Returning Citizens outreach prior to release.

In an effort to assist soon-to-be-released returning citizens in clearing their driver records, the Driver Services Administration staff will partner with federal prisons (specifically Federal Correctional Institute, Cumberland) to conduct outreach. DMV employees will meet individually with returning citizens scheduled to be released within 6 months and advise them of all their outstanding DMV issues and make recommendations for resolution.

Status: In November 2014, DC DMV, in partnership with the Office of Returning Citizens, visited the Federal Correctional Institute in Cumberland to conduct outreach for those DC residents scheduled to be released within 6 months. Funding was \$0.00.

INITIATIVE 15: Implement Full Reciprocity Plan (FRP).

In accordance with a ballot vote among all US jurisdictions, DMV will implement the Full Reciprocity Plan (FRP). The FRP will change the International Registration Plan (IRP) to make the Plan more efficient, more equitable and more flexible for its member jurisdictions and registrants by granting full reciprocity for all apportioned vehicles in all member IRP jurisdictions. It will also remove from the Plan any provisions related to estimated distance.

Status: By January 2015, DC DMV implemented the FRP. Funding was absorbed in the existing IRP budget.



INITIATIVE 16: Create safe driving self-assessment.

To assist drivers and concerned family members, DMV will create an online driving selfassessment that can be used to determine one's ability to continue to safely operative a motor vehicle. This assessment will assist in highlighting skills and/or competencies where a driver may have become deficient.

Status: By January 2015, DC DMV created a safe driving self-assessment which was delivered to high school students. Funding was \$1,000.
