A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on an emergency basis, the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978 to approve the salary adjustment submitted by the Mayor for the position of the Chancellor of the District of Columbia Public Schools.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Chancellor of the District of Columbia Public Schools Salary Adjustment Emergency Amendment Act of 2015”.

Sec. 2. Section 1052 of the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, effective June 10, 1998 (D.C. Law 12-124; D.C. Official Code § 1-610.52), is amended as follows:

(a) Subsection (b)(2) is amended by striking the phrase “the Chancellor of the District of Columbia Public Schools Kaya Henderson (\$275,000),” and inserting the following phrase: “the Chancellor of the District of Columbia Public Schools Kaya Henderson (\$284,000),”.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

Sec. 4. Effective date.

(a) The annual salary adjustment of \$284,000 is effective retroactively on January 2, 2015, upon the effective date of this act.

1 (b) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
2 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for
3 no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District
4 of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
5 December 24, 193 (87 Stat. 88; Pub. L. 93-198; D.C. Official Code § 204.12(a)).
