15	To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need
16	to amend the Health Services Planning Program Re-establishment Act of 1996 to exempt
17	the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation from the certificate-of-need requirements for a
18	period of one year for the establishment of an ambulatory care clinic in Ward 8, provided
19	that it establishes 2 mobile health clinics to operate in Wards 7 and 8.

21	RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
22	resolution may be cited as the "Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation Certificate of Need
23	Exemption Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2015."

25	Sec. 2. (a) The Council passed the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation Certificate of
26	Need Exemption Emergency Amendment Act of 2014, enacted on January 6, 2014 (D.C. Act 20-
27	563; 62 DCR 491) ("emergency legislation"), and the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation
28	Certificate of Need Exemption Temporary Amendment Act of 2014, enacted on February 5,
29	2015 (D.C. Act 20-623; 62 DCR 1960) ("temporary legislation"), which amended the Health
30	Services Planning Program Re-establishment Act of 1996 to exempt the Not-for-Profit Hospital
31	Corporation from the certificate-of-need requirements for a period of one year for the
32	establishment of an ambulatory care clinic in Ward 8; provided, that it establishes 2 mobile
33	health clinics to operate in Wards 7 and 8.
34	(b) The emergency legislation will expire on April 6, 2015, before the temporary
35	legislation is projected to become law.

- 36 (c) It is important that the provisions of the emergency legislation continue in effect,
  37 without interruption, until the temporary legislation becomes law.
- 38 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
- 39 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Not-
- 40 For-Profit Hospital Corporation Certificate of Need Exemption Congressional Review
- 41 Emergency Amendment Act of 2015 be adopted after a single reading.
- 42 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
