Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces a public hearing before the Committee of the Whole on Bill 22-463, the “Rolark Place and Calvin and Wilhelmina Rolark Way Designation Act of 2017”. The hearing will be held at 9:30 a.m. on **Thursday, December 14, 2017** in Hearing Room 123 of the John A. Wilson Building.

The stated purpose of Bill 22-463 is to officially designate the 500 block of Foxhall Place, S.E. in Square 6126, in Ward 8, as Rolark Place, S.E.; and to ceremonial designate the 500 block of Foxhall Place, S.E. in Square 6126, in Ward 8 as Calvin and Wilhelmina Rolark Way, S.E.

Witnesses should limit their testimony to four minutes; less time will be allowed if there are a large number of witnesses. If you are unable to testify at the hearing, written statements are encouraged and will be made a part of the official record. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20004. The record will close at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 28, 2017.
