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On Monday, January 22, 2018, Councilmember Mary M. Cheh, Chairperson of the Committee on the Transportation and the Environment, will hold a public oversight roundtable on the District's leaf collection program. The Department of Public Works (DPW) is responsible for leaf collection in the District. At this roundtable, the Committee will examine the current operations of DPW's leaf collection program, including reports of delays in leaf pick up and other scheduling concerns, and consider potential improvements to the program.
