On Friday, November 16, 2018, Councilmember Mary M. Cheh, Chairperson of the Committee on Transportation and the Environment, will hold a public hearing and roundtable on the District's Snow Removal Operations Plan for Winter 2018 - 2019 and B22-752, the Warnings Before Citations Amendment Act of 2018. The roundtable will begin at 12:00 PM in Room 500 of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W.

The purpose of the hearing and roundtable is to examine the Department of Public Works' readiness for the coming snow season and ability to coordinate with other entities. The Department of Public Works has primary responsibility for the District's snow removal operations. Efficient operations require the participation and coordination of many government agencies and hundreds of employees. The Committee will also hear testimony regarding B22-752, the Warnings Before Citations Amendment Act of 2018, would require DPW to issue a warning to residents at least 7 days before issuing a citation for a violation of laws related to solid waste collection.

The Committee invites the public to testify or to submit written testimony, which will be made a part of the official record.
