## B22-954, THE "YOUTH EXITING WITH SUPPORT AMENDMENT ACT OF 2018"

On Thursday, October 18, 2018, Councilmember Brianne K. Nadeau, Chairperson of the Committee on Human Services, will hold a public hearing on B22-954, the "Youth Exiting with Support Amendment Act of 2018". The hearing will take place in Room 120 of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, at 10:00 a.m.

The stated purpose of B22-954, the "Youth Exiting with Support Amendment Act of 2018", is to better inform youth exiting the care of the Department of Youth Rehabilitation Services of programs and services that would assist in providing information on work, vocational training, and other services. In addition, this bill would allow youth formerly identified as persons in need of supervision, and survivors of commercial sexual exploitation to receive services from the Department of Human Services from age 18-21 on a voluntary basis and create individual care plans for youth who are homeless or are at high risk of becoming homeless.

The Committee invites the public to testify or to submit written testimony. Representatives of organizations will be allowed a maximum of five minutes for oral testimony, and individuals will be allowed a maximum of three minutes. Witnesses are encouraged to bring <u>twenty single-sided copies</u> of their written testimony.

For witnesses who are unable to testify at the hearing, written statements will be made part of the official record.
