On Thursday, November 29, 2018, Councilmember Charles Allen, Chairperson of the Committee on the Judiciary and Public Safety, will convene a public roundtable to consider PR22-1042, the "Homeland Security Commission Edward Pearson Confirmation Resolution of 2018"; PR22-1044, the "Homeland Security Commission Brian Baker Confirmation Resolution of 2018"; PR22-1045, the "Corrections Information Council Charlie Whitaker Confirmation Resolution of 2018"; PR22-1089, the "Police Complaints Board Paul Ashton Confirmation Resolution of 2018"; PR22-1107, the "District of Columbia Commission on Human Rights Eleanor Collinson Confirmation Resolution of 2018"; PR22-1110, the "District of Columbia Commission on Human Rights Gunther Sanabria Confirmation Resolution of 2018"; and PR22-1135, the "Police Complaints Board Jeffrey Hines Tignor Confirmation Resolution of 2018". PR22-1042 and PR22-1044 would appoint Edward Pearson and Brian Baker, respectively, to the Homeland Security Commission for terms to end February 20, 2021.

PR22-1045 would appoint Charlie Whitaker to the Corrections Information Council for a term to end June 7, 2020.

PR22-1089 and PR22-1135 would reappoint Paul Ashton and Jeffrey Tignor, respectively, to the Police Complaints Board terms to end January 12, 2022 and January 12, 2021.

PR22-1107 and PR22-1110 would reappoint Eleanor Collinson and Gunther Sanabria, respectively, to the Commission on Human Rights for terms to end December 31, 2021.

The Committee invites the public to testify or to submit written testimony. Representatives of organizations will be allowed a maximum of five minutes for oral testimony, and individuals will be allowed a maximum of three minutes. Witnesses should bring **twenty double-sided copies** of their written testimony and, if possible, also submit a copy of their testimony electronically in advance to [judiciary@dccouncil.us](mailto:judiciary@dccouncil.us).
