The District Department of Transportation's Second Proposed Vision Zero Regulations

On Friday, March 3, 2017, Councilmember Mary M. Cheh, Chairperson of the Committee on Transportation and the Environment, will hold a public oversight roundtable on the second iteration of the District Department of Transportation's Vision Zero regulations. The public oversight roundtable will begin at 1:00 PM in Room 412 of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W.

The purpose of the roundtable is to discuss and to hear testimony regarding the District Department of Transportation's proposed Vision Zero regulations, which were issued for the second time on January 20, 2017. These regulations would, among other things, raise the fines for a number of traffic offenses; create several new traffic offenses; and reduce the maximum speed on roadways adjacent to school facilities and grounds serving youth, playgrounds, recreational facilities, pools, athletic fields, or senior centers.
