Councilmember Anita Bonds, Chairperson of the Committee on Housing and Community Development, will hold a public roundtable on PR22-0273, the “Rent Administrator Lauren Pair Confirmation Resolution of 2017” and PR22-0324, the “District of Columbia Housing Authority Board of Commissioners Neil Albert Confirmation Resolution of 2017”. The public roundtable will be held on Wednesday, June 7, 2017, at 10:00 AM in Room 412 of the John A. Wilson Building.

The stated purpose of PR22-0273 is to confirm the appointment of Lauren Pair as Rent Administrator of the District of Columbia for a term to end three years from the date of confirmation. The stated purpose of PR22-0324 is to confirm the appointment of Neil Albert as a public commissioner of the District of Columbia Housing Authority Board of Commissioners, replacing Moses Clarence Mobley, for a term ending July 12, 2019.
