Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces a public hearing before the Committee of the Whole on Bill 22-957, the "Open Movie Captioning Requirement Act of 2018". The hearing will be held at 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, December 11, 2018 in the Council Chamber of the John A. Wilson Building.

The stated purpose of **Bill 22-957** is to require that movie theatres captioning during movie showing at specified times; to provide that a violation shall be an unlawful discriminatory practice; and to require notice of the requirements of this act.
