17	amend the District of Columbia Uniform Controlled Substances Act of 1981 to add certain

20	RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
21	resolution may be cited as the "Revised Synthetics Abatement and Full Enforcement Drug Control
22	Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2018".
23	Sec. 2. (a) On October 2, 2018, the Council passed the Revised Synthetics Abatement and
24	Full Enforcement Drug Control Emergency Amendment Act of 2018, effective October 12, 2018
25	(D.C. Act 22-0464; 65 DCR 11377), which will expire on January 3, 2019.
26	(b) On October 16, 2018, the Council passed the Revised Synthetics Abatement and Full
27	Enforcement Drug Control Temporary Amendment Act of 2018, effective November 8, 2018
28	(D.C. Act 22-0503; 65 DCR 12338), which is pending congressional transmittal.
29	(c) On November 12, 2018, the Council held the first reading of the Revised Synthetics
30	Abatement and Full Enforcement Drug Control Amendment Act of 2018. The second reading of
31	the bill is scheduled to take place on December 4, 2018.
32	(c) This congressional review emergency is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between
33	the expiration of the temporary act and the effective date of the permanent act.

Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Revised
Synthetics Abatement and Full Enforcement Drug Control Congressional Review Emergency
Amendment Act of 2018 be adopted after a single reading.
