Councilmember Jack Evans, Chairman of the Committee on Finance and Revenue, announces a public roundtable to be held on Monday, November 19, 2018 at 9:45 a.m. in Room 412, of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20004.

PR 22-1093, the “Launchpad Development Revenue Bonds Project Approval Resolution of 2018” would authorize for the issuance, sale, and delivery in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$32 million of District of Columbia revenue bonds in one or more series and to authorize and provide for the loan of the proceeds to assist Launchpad Development Company or Launchpad Development One DC, LLC, in the financing, refinancing, or reimbursing of costs associated with an authorized project pursuant to section 490 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act. The project includes financing the acquisition of land and a facility located at 2335 Reynolds Place SE in Ward 8 to be used as a public charter school campus, commonly known as Rocketship Rise Academy Public Charter School.
