

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, multiyear Contract No. DOEE-2016-C-0002 with the Vermont Energy Investment Corporation to provide performance-based services in administering sustainable energy programs in the District of Columbia.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Contract No. DOEE-2016-C-0002 Emergency Approval Resolution of 2018.”

Sec. 2. (a) The Office of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development, on behalf of the Department of Energy and Environment, proposes to modify the multiyear Contract No. DOEE-2016-C-0002 with Vermont Energy Investment Corporation, the designated Sustainable Energy Utility (SEU), to add the implementation of the Solar for All Program (“SfA Program”) and the Emergency HVAC Program for low income households.

(b) The price of the contract modification under this multiyear contract with Vermont Energy Investment Corporation will be in the not to exceed amount of \$33,351,666.00. The new total 5-year multiyear amount of the contract will be in the not to exceed amount of \$128,982,598.50. The term of the contract modification will be from date of award through September 30, 2021.

5 Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia
6 Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; Pub. L. 93-198; D.C. Official Code
7 § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

8 Sec. 5. The Secretary to the Council shall transmit a copy of this resolution, upon its
9 adoption, to the Mayor.
