The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority consists of 17 Members, who form its Board of Directors. The Board establishes policy and provides direction to management, and its authority is plenary. Members of the Board are appointed by the Governors of Virginia and Maryland, the Mayor of the District of Columbia, and the President of the United States as follows:

- The Governor of Virginia appoints seven Members, subject to confirmation by the Virginia General Assembly;
- The Governor of Maryland appoints three Members;
- The Mayor of the District of Columbia appoints four Members, subject to confirmation by the D.C. Council; and
- The President appoints three Members with the advice and consent of the U.S. Senate.

Members' terms are for six years, and can be reappointed once. The Board elects a Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary, annually.

The Airports Authority has two enterprise funds, Aviation and Dulles Corridor. Aviation activities are funded from airline rates and charges, airport concessions, bond proceeds, passenger facility charges and grants (Federal and Commonwealth of Virginia). Dulles Corridor activities are currently funded with Dulles Toll road revenues, bond proceeds, Federal Transit Administration grant, transportation Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act (TIFIA) proceeds, and contributions from Fairfax County and the Commonwealth of Virginia.

The Airports Authority has six budgeted programs, five that include ongoing capital projects. The largest of these projects is the Metrorail Phases 1 and 2. The remaining projects include repair work, planning, design, and construction for airport and Dulles Corridor projects other than rail facilities. All projects are specific to the Airports Authority's operations and receive no District of Columbia funding. All active capital projects are included in the Airports Authority 2017 Budget.



- Provide safe and efficient services and facilities for the traveling public.
- Strengthen the competitive position of Washington Dulles International Airport, and hold the airport's cost per enplaned passenger below \$19, through revenue enhancement, growth of domestic and international air service, a continuing focus on the customer experience and improvements in the quality of facilities and services.
- Maintain cost discipline, manage operations within budgets and exercise conservative financial management across all Airports Authority functions.
- Move forward with planning and construction of major capital improvements at Reagan National Airport and with the Metro Silver Line Project, exercising best practices in safety and cost management and keeping customers and the public informed about progress and construction impacts.
- Work with community representatives, airlines and the Federal Aviation
   Administration to facilitate discussions through the Reagan National Community
   Working Group and other avenues to address regional concerns related to aircraft
   noise.

Each of these priorities is the focus of the entire organization with execution assigned to specific functional areas within the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority. In some cases specific departmental goals are linked to progress made in achieving assigned aspects of each goal.
