The FY16 proposed budget for OPGS reflects a \$19,369.83 reduction in the fringe benefit rate compared to this rate in FY15. This change results from the District agency-wide lower fringe rate technical adjustment.

4. Will the proposed FY16 budget allow the agency to meet all statutory mandates? If not, please explain.

Yes, OPGS anticipates that the proposed FY16 budget will allow it to meet its current statutory grant development and donations management responsibilities pursuant to Mayor's Order 2011-170 dated October 5, 2011.

5. What donations has the District received during Fiscal Year 2015 so far, and what is anticipated to be received for Fiscal Year 2016? Are there any donations the District is not properly positioned to receive? If so, please suggest actions necessary to correct.

To date in FY15, the Office of Partnerships and Grant Services has authorized the acceptance of approximately \$5.3 Million in total donation receipts, including \$900K to the DC Public Education Fund, to government agencies subject to the Rules of Conduct Governing Donations to the District Government (Mayor's Memorandum 2012-3 dated May 16, 2012). On March 3, 2015, OPGS conducted agency-wide donation management training for 108 government employees who are responsible for their agencies compliance with the District's Donation process. Thus OPGS does not anticipate that the District agencies subject to the authority of the Mayor will be improperly positioned to receive donations in FY15 or FY16.
