  - c. A secure community placement in the District of Columbia; Community placements are settings that allow youth to go to school, work, and attend other community services and obligations. At this time, DYRS uses no secure community placements.
  - d. A non-secure community placement in the District of Columbia; Includes group homes, foster care, family home, independent living, and abscondence.
  - e. A residential treatment facility in the District of Columbia; *Includes in-patient substance abuse treatment and hospital placement.*
  - f. A secure out-of-the-District placement; and Includes residential treatment centers, hospital, in-patient substance abuse treatment.
  - g. A non-secure out-of-the-District placement.
