On Thursday, January 24, 2019, Councilmember Anita Bonds and Ward 8 Councilmember Trayon White, Sr. will hold a joint public roundtable to discuss how the Department of Housing and Community Development transitioned the receivership of Park Southern located at 800 Southern Avenue to Vesta Management and the financial state of the building at the time the government transferred ownership.
