11 12	RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
13	resolution may be cited as the "Reprogramming No. 23-0004 Disapproval Emergency Declaration
14	Resolution of 2019".
15	Sec. 2. (a) There exists an emergency to disapprove the reprogramming request No. 23-
16	0004 of \$54,930,000 of Capital Funds Budget Authority and Allotment from Various Agencies
17	to the District of Columbia Public School and the Department of Parks and Recreation to
18	addresses immediate concerns.
19	(b) This reprogramming sweeps \$21,000,000 from the Fort Dupont Ice Arena
20	replacement, making it impossible to perform the complete modernization of the current ice
21	arena, which is critically important to provide access for low- and middle-income District
22	children, many of whom live in Wards 7 and 8 and most of whom are girls and African-
23	American, who would otherwise not have access to the programming offered at the Ice Arena.

24	(b) Reprogramming No. 23-0004 was introduced January 25, 2019 and is scheduled to be
25	deemed approved February 11, 2019.
26	(c) With the introduction of a resolution of disapproval, the Council would then have 30
27	calendar days from the reprogramming's introduction to take final action, resulting in the
28	Council having to take final action by February 24, 2019.
29	(d) The only scheduled legislative meeting for the Council to take final action before
30	February 24, 2019 is on February 5, 2019.
31	(e) There is insufficient time for notice for a permanent measure to be considered at the
32	February 5, 2019 legislative meeting.
33	Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
34	enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
35	Reprogramming No. 23-0004 Emergency Disapproval Resolution of 2019 be adopted after a
36	single reading.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
