### **ABOUT THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA**

The Council of the District of Columbia is the legislative branch of the District of Columbia government. The Council's central role as a legislative body is to make laws. As the chief policy-making body for the District of Columbia, the Council's mission is to provide strong, innovative and effective leadership for the benefit of residents across the city. The Council's responsibilities also include approving the government's annual budget and oversight of agencies, commissions, boards and other instruments of District government.

### **GOVERNMENT AND BUDGET OVERSIGHT**

Council committees review the performance of government programs and agencies to ensure they are serving their established purposes and operating under pertinent regulations and budget targets. The Council also holds annual budget oversight hearings in preparation for approving a city budget recommended by the Mayor. The law requires that the District operate with a balanced budget so expenditures do not exceed income.

### **CONSTITUENT SERVICES**

Responding to constituents' concerns is a major responsibility for the Council. Staff members are assigned to find solutions for problems and address complaints. You can contact your Councilmember's office directly or call the Council's general line at 202 724 8000


