23	resolution may be cited as the "Small and Certified Business Enterprise Development and
24	Assistance Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2019".
25	Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to amend the Small and Certified Business Enterprise
26	Development and Assistance Act of 2005 to provide financial assistance to distressed businesses
27	that have experienced significant financial losses as a result of the District-financed capital
28	infrastructure projects of District-owned property.
29	(b) As a result of the ongoing construction, renovation, replacement, maintenance, or
30	improvement of District-owned infrastructure, several highways, roads, bridges, and metro
31	stations were temporarily shut down from May 2018 through September 2018 affecting small
32	business owners whose businesses are in close proximity to the capital infrastructure projects.
33	(c) The capital infrastructure projects disincentivized patrons from driving, walking,

- riding, or taking the metro to patronize the small businesses in close proximity to the affected projects and this inadvertently disturbed their revenue stream.
- (d) The emergency legislation would allocate funds to eligible small businesses in this predicament to mitigate the financial distress they are experiencing and minimize the chances of a similar situation occurring in the future.
- Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Small and Certified Business Enterprise Development and Assistance Emergency Amendment Act of 2019 be adopted after a single reading.
- Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
