A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 to Contract No. CW36154 with WM Recycle America, LLC to transport, process, and market recyclables from the District’s residential recycling drop-off facilities and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modifications to Exercise Option Year Three (3) of Contract No. CW36154 with WM Recycle America, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2019”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1–204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18–371; D.C. Official Code § 2–352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 to Contract No. CW36154 with WM Recycle America, LLC to transport, process, and market recyclables from the District’s residential recycling drop-off facilities, and authorizes payment in the amount

34 of \$2,500,000 for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification  
35 Nos. 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12.

36           Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Chief Financial  
37 Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative  
38 Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code  
39 § 1–301.47a).

40           Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the  
41 event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain  
42 in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the  
43 District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,  
44 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1–204.12(a)).
