A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 46 and 47 to Contract No. POKV-2006-C-0064 with Conduent State & Local Solutions, Inc. to provide ticket processing and related services for the District Department of Motor Vehicles and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. POKV-2006-C-0064 with Conduent State & Local Solutions, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2019”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. 46 and 47 to Contract No. POKV-2006-C-0064 with Conduent State & Local Solutions, Inc. to provide ticket processing and related services for the District Department of Motor Vehicles, and authorizes payment in the amount of \$8,736,368.00 for goods and services received and to be received under Modification Nos. 46 and 47.

35 Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Chief Financial
36 Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative
37 Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code
38 § 1-301.47a).

39 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the
40 event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain
41 in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the
42 District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
43 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
