The Commission received no funding in FY18 or FY19, to date or any previous year. The Commission operates with technical and clerical support provided on an ad hoc basis by DCOA.

5. Please describe the Commission's activities in FY18 and FY19, to date.

The Commission's activities in FY18 concentrated and successfully brought the much-needed attention and resources to Elder Abuse. The tenacity and drive of former Chair Carolyn Nicholas accomplished this feat by never giving in. As a result, we have the necessary resources to keep tabs and impose criminal charges on those who violate seniors. As a Commission we were able to help increase funding for Transportation, Safe at Home, Security Cameras, also additional attention to Home Health Aides, Nutrition, LGBT, homebound and the underserved.

In FY19, we are finally assessing the dynamics that will be needed to achieve our goals. Chairman Guleford Bobo is restructuring how the meetings are conducted going forward. Instead of having guest speakers every month we will entertain speakers every other month. Depending upon the issues before the Commissioners it may be every two months. The start of FY19 will be a stricter adherence to the responsibilities of the Commissioners and more group participation.

6. Please describe the Commission's goals in FY19 and the plan/timeline for completion.

These are the goals of the Commission for FY19. The stumbling blocks that Seniors have identified are being discussed researched and planned for resolution in the near future. On behalf of seniors, we plan to advocate for:

- oversight of Senior Case Managers;
- the establishment of villages in all eight wards.
- more Senior training and employment opportunities throughout the city;
- for continued financing for the Safe at Home Program;
- an increase in Senior Housing in the District of Columbia;
- the need to provide permanent, appropriate shelter for homeless Elderly D. C. Residents
- DCOA to monitor all DCOA grantees to ensure inclusion of all D. C. Seniors; and
- DCOA to continue to work with other government agencies charged with addressing Elder Abuse to inform and educate the public.

- Additional staffing – facility management staff person, activity coordinator for the BFSWC
- Expanding parking options
- Improved Wi-Fi access
- Upgraded computer equipment almost 9 years old – BFSWC
- Exterior signage and upgrades for some Centers
- Landscaping service to maintain green roof
- Additional funding and services for alcohol and drug addiction treatment for seniors.

We will also encourage DCOA's Executive Director to continue the vigorous distribution of brochures and other literature that informs and educates Seniors and the general population about DCOA activities, programs, and services provided by other D. C. Government Agencies.

7. What are the Commission's biggest strengths?

The Commission's biggest strength is the ability to see challenges through completion. Never giving up and presenting as a UNITED FRONT!

8. What were the Commission's biggest accomplishments in FY18?

The Commission's biggest accomplishments in FY18 was successfully advocating for the enforcement of L21-66, "Financial Exploitation of Vulnerable Adults and the Elderly Amendment Act of 2016," Safe at Home, Solar Panels, Security Cameras, and more funding for transportation and nutrition.

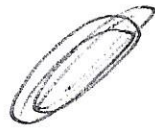
