Councilmember Brandon T. Todd announces the scheduling of a public hearing by the Committee on Government Operations on *B23-0038*, the Racial Equity Achieves Results Amendment Act of 2019. The public hearing is scheduled for Thursday, April 25, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 120 of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Ave., NW, Washington, DC 20004.

B22-0038 amends the Office of Human Rights Establishment Act of 1999 to require the Office of Human Rights and the Department of Human Resources to develop and provide racial equity training for District employees, amends Chapter 3 of Title 47 of the District of Columbia Official Code to require the Office of Budget and Planning to design and implement a racial equity tool to aid in eliminating disparities among District employees based on race, and, beginning in fiscal year 2020, requires the Mayor to include racial equity-related performance measures in the development of an agency's annual performance plans, and requires the Mayor to include an evaluation of the use of the racial equity tool in the annual performance accountability reports.
