The Executive Office of the Mayor (EOM) is often named in lawsuits that primarily concern the actions of other District agencies. Conducting due diligence, OAG may send EOM litigation holds indicating that its files or actions may be at issue or that the Mayor was named in her official capacity. EOM is able to follow up with the Committee and OAG if the Committee has any follow-up questions concerning a particular suit.

Cases in which EOM is the primary defendant:

Beth Gouse v. District of Columbia, 1:17-cv02566 RDM

Plaintiff alleges that the District of Columbia discriminated against her on the basis of race and sex in violation of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the District of Columbia Human Rights Act, and retaliated against her for engaging in protected EEO activity.

Cases in which EOM is not the primary defendant, but has received litigation holds:

• District of Columbia v. Digi Media, 2016 CA 006471 B

The District of Columbia filed a lawsuit against Digi Media for unlawfully erecting large outdoor digital signs around the District.

 Petworth Holdings et al. v. Muriel Bowser, et al., District Court for the District of Columbia, Case No. 1:18-cv-00003 (case stayed)

This is active litigation that was filed in January 2018. Plaintiff alleges that the Boards and Commissions Reform Act of 2013, which amended the Retail Services Station Act, constituted a regulatory taking of their property by preventing them from tearing down the service station and selling the land for new construction.

• Current Area Residents East of the River, et al. v. District of Columbia, et al., Civil Action No. 18-872 (D.D.C.)

Plaintiffs are three District residents and C.A.R.E., an organization comprised of African-American District residents living east of the Anacostia River. They allege defendants have maintained a land-use and economic development policy of favoring a "creative class" (millennials who are college educated) over "legacy DC residents" (African-Americans who are economically disadvantaged). Plaintiffs allege this dynamic has led to the exodus of economically disadvantaged African-American families from their neighborhoods and assert the following claims: geographic discrimination in violation of the Fifth Amendment and District of Columbia Human Rights Act (DCHRA); age and source of income discrimination in violation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VI) and the DCHRA; disparate impact in violation of the Fair



Housing Act and the DCHRA; violation of plaintiffs' First Amendment right of freedom of association and rights under the Establishment Clause; racial animus in violation of Title VI; and conspiracy to violate their Title VI rights.

Black Lives Matter, D.C., et al. v. Muriel Bowser, et al., Civil Action No. 2018 CA 003168 B

Plaintiffs filed for injunctive relief against the District alleging that the District have unreasonably delayed implementation of Title II(G) of the Neighborhood Engagement Achieves Results (NEAR) Act of 2016.

• M.J., et al. v. the District of Columbia, et al., Civil Action No. 18-1901 (EGS) (D.D.C.)

This litigation seeks a declaration that the Defendants have failed to comply with mandates of the Americans with Disabilities Act, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, and the Medicaid Act.

Proctor v. D.C., 1:18-cv-00701

The litigation challenges the District's application of its Protocol for the Disposition of Property Found on Public Space and Outreach to Displaced Persons.


