PR 23-192, the “Friendship Public Charter School, Inc. Revenue Bonds Project Approval Resolution of 2019” would authorize and provide for the issuance, sale and delivery in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$17,200,000 of District of Columbia revenue bonds in one or more series and to authorize and provide for the loan of the proceeds of the bonds to assist Friendship Public Charter School, Inc. in the financing, refinancing, or reimbursing of costs associated with an authorized project pursuant to section 490 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act. This project is located at 6130 North Capitol Street, NW in Ward 4.

PR 23-200, the “Edmund Burke School, Inc., Revenue Refunding Bonds Project Approval Resolution of 2019” would authorize and provide for the issuance, sale, and delivery in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$17 million of the District of Columbia revenue refunding bonds in one or more series and to authorize and to provide for the loan of the proceeds of the bonds to assist the Edmund Burke School, Inc., in the financing, refinancing, or reimbursing of costs associated with an authorized project pursuant to section 490 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act. This project is located at 4101 Connecticut Avenue, NW in Ward 3.
