A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, multiyear Contract No. DCAM-18-NC-0093E with Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc. to provide recycling hauling services at District of Columbia Municipal Facilities Front load services in Wards 5 through 8 and Laurel, MD.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Multiyear Contract No. DCAM-18-NC-0093E with Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc. Emergency Approval Resolution of 2019”.

Sec. 2 (a) The District of Columbia Department of General Services (the “Department”) proposes to enter into multiyear, Contract No. DCAM-18-NC-0093E, (the “Contract”) with Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc. to provide recycling hauling services at properties identified as Aggregate Award Group 5, to include the District of Columbia Municipal Facilities Front load services in Wards 5 through 8 and Laurel, MD.

1 (b) The estimated Not-To-Exceed amount of the multiyear Contract is
2 \$330,672.00 for a 2-year base period (the “Base Period”) from November 7, 2018
3 through November 6, 2020.

4 (c) Recycling hauling services, under the proposed Contract, are necessary to
5 ensure the collection and removal of recyclables and waste materials in a cost effective
6 and environmentally safe and secure manner within the District of Columbia.

7 Sec. 3. Pursuant to section 451(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
8 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; Pub. L. 93-198; D.C. Official Code § 1-
9 204.51(c)(3)), the Council approves Contract No. DCAM-18-NC-0093E).

10 Sec. 4. The Council adopts the fiscal statement provided by the Office of the
11 Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4(a) of the
12 General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038;
13 D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47(a)).

14 Sec. 5. The Secretary to the Council shall transmit a copy of this resolution, upon
15 its adoption, to the Mayor.

16 Sec. 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
