A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve multiyear Contract No. DCAM-18-NC-0093A with Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc. to provide recycling hauling services at District of Columbia Public Libraries in Wards 1 through 8.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Multiyear Contract No. DCAM-18-NC-0093A with Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc. Approval Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2019”.

Sec. 2.(a) There exists an immediate need to approve multiyear Contract No. DCAM-18-NC-0093A with Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc., (the “Contract”) for recycling hauling services to be provided at properties, identified as Aggregate Award Group 1, to include the District of Columbia Public Libraries, Wards 1 through 8, in the estimated Not-To-Exceed (“NTE”) amount of \$190,885.60 for a 2-year base period (the “Base Period”) from November 7, 2018 through November 6, 2020.

1 (b) Recycling hauling services are necessary to ensure the collection and removal
2 of recyclables and waste materials in a cost effective and environmentally safe and secure
3 manner within the District of Columbia.

4 (c) The Base Period of the proposed Contract exceeds twelve (12) months and
5 thus Council approval of the Contract is required pursuant to section 451(c)(3) of the
6 District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; Pub. L.
7 93-198; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51(c)(3)).

8 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
9 enumerated in Section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
10 “Multiyear Contract No. DCAM-18-NC-0093A with Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc.
11 Emergency Approval Resolution of 2019” be adopted after a single reading.

12 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
