21	Sec. 2. The Commission on the Arts and Humanities Independence and Funding
22	Restructuring Amendment Act of 2019, effective September 11, 2019 (D.C. Law 23-16; to be
23	codified D.C. Official Code § 39-201 et seq.), is amended by adding a new section 2204 to read
24	as follows:
25	"Section 2204. Applicability.
26	"This subtitle shall apply as of July 22, 2019.".
27	Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.
28	The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact
29	statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved
30	October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).
31	Sec. 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
