

A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on a temporary basis, section 3902 of Title 24 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations to allow access to body worn camera footage for the close relatives of a subject depicted in the footage, if the subject is deceased.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Access to Body Worn Camera Footage Temporary Amendment Act of 2019”.

Sec. 2. Section 24-3902.5 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations is amended by striking subparagraph (a) and inserting the following subparagraph in its place:

“(a) Pursuant to policy directives adopted under the authority of § 3900.3, the Department shall schedule a time for the following individuals to view the BWC recording at the police station in the police district where the incident occurred. Access shall be provided to the subject, the subject’s parent or legal guardian if the subject is a minor, and the subject’s legal representative. If the subject is deceased, the subject’s parent, legal guardian, next of kin, and their respective legal representatives shall be granted access. Access to BWC footage shall be granted provided, that:”

38 (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
39 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review
40 as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
41 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
42 Columbia Register.

43 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
