BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Eastern Downtown Cycletrack Project Completion Emergency Amendment Act of 2019".		
Sec. 2. Section 47-362 or	f the District of Columbia Official Code is a	amended by adding a
new subsection (h) to read as fol	llows:	
"(h)(1) Notwithstanding § 47-363, after August 1, 2020, the District Department of		
Transportation ("DDOT") shall not, unless the Council has approved the action by resolution,		
make a capital reprogramming until the following conditions on 9th Street, N.W., between		
Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., and	d Florida Avenue, N.W., have been met:	
"(A) The number of vehi	cle travel lanes in the northbound direction	between
Massachusetts Avenue, N.W., ar	nd Florida Avenue, N.W., are reduced from	2 to 1 through lanes;
"(B) A full-time vehicle	parking lane is removed between H Street,	N.W., and E Street
N.W.;		
"(C) Design elements are	e installed to ensure that all right-of-way wi	dth affected by the
reduction in lanes described in s	ubparagraph (A) of this paragraph are avail	able for use
exclusively by modes of transpo	ortation other than motor vehicles, as that ter	rm is defined in
