| 31 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this |
| 32 | act may be cited as the "Eastern Downtown Cycletrack Project Completion Temporary |
| 33 | Amendment Act of 2019". |
| 34 | Sec. 2. Section 47-362 of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended by adding a |
| 35 | new subsection (i) to read as follows: |
| 36 | "(i)(1) Notwithstanding § 47-363, after August 1, 2020, the District Department of |
| 37 | Transportation ("DDOT") shall not, unless the Council has approved the action by resolution, |

| 38 | make a capital reprogramming until the following conditions on 9th Street, N.W., between |
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| 39 | Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., and Florida Avenue, N.W., have been met: |
| 40 | "(A) The number of vehicle travel lanes in the northbound direction |
| 41 | between Massachusetts Avenue, N.W., and Florida Avenue, N.W., are reduced from 2 to 1 |
| 42 | through lanes; |
| 43 | "(B) A full-time vehicle parking lane is removed between H Street, N.W. |
| 44 | and E Street, N.W.; |
| 45 | "(C) Design elements are installed to ensure that all right-of-way width |
| 46 | affected by the reduction in lanes described in subparagraph (A) of this paragraph are available |
| 47 | for use exclusively by modes of transportation other than motor vehicles, as that term is defined |
| 48 | in section 8 of An Act To provide for the annual inspection of all motor vehicles in the District |
| 49 | of Columbia, approved February 18, 1938 (57 Stat. 78; D.C. Official Code § 50-1108); and |
| 50 | "(D) High-visibility crosswalk markings are installed at all locations that |
| 51 | meet the standards for high-visibility crosswalk markings in DDOT's 2019 Design and |

| 53 | "(E) The total curb width designated for use as Sunday angled parking |
| 54 | between N Street N.W., and T Street N.W., is not reduced. |
| 55 | "(2) On February 4, 2020, and the first Tuesday of each month thereafter, DDOT |
| 56 | shall submit to the Council committee with oversight over DDOT and the Councilmembers |

| 74 | (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by |
| 75 | the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review |

| 77 | 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of |
