Thank you Greg. This is a good start but we still need some more detail before we can approval and allow the signs to be installed. Below are a few key areas that we need to understand. Are you available tomorrow or Monday? I think it would be beneficial for us all to jump on a call to discuss rather than back and forth emails.

- 1) Drawing set lacks overall architectural drawings of the exterior of the building. Where the signs are affixed to the building exterior? I know you provided renderings but we need drawings showing the exact location. For example, dimensions of how far above the starbuck's door is the sign located?
- 2) Lack of structural drawings. Have the anchoring points and live and dead loads imposed to the building exterior been evaluated by a Structural Engineer for the various exterior anchoring points and impacts on building skin such as being affixed to existing precast hung panels etc.
- 3) No water proof details provided. What steps are being takin in the design to ensure water tightness of the exterior of the building?
- 4) Drawing set lacks electrical drawings. How are these electrified signs being wired to the base building and will there be any exposed conduit to the exterior or interior of the building? How does this electrical wiring enter the building and are these penetrations being made water tight?


