Donald, this emergency rule was adopted by the City Administrator under his authority and not the Council. However, the proposed rule is still subject to Council approval before its deem permanent. Obviously, a new challenge for our team. The City Administrator issued the Notice of Emergency and Proposed Rulemaking on July 12, 2016, effective on that date. The rule was issued under his authority and remains in effect for 120 days. Further, following public comment in the next forty (45) day review period the proposed rule with be submitted to the Council for review. The real opportunity to defeat the rule will be when its referred to the Council. The Council is not back in session until mid-September.

However, for now the emergency rule is in effect and the signs will require permits. I will reach out to Rashad this morning to discuss this matter as well to obtain additional information that may prove helpful.
