I have been promised that Beverly, Rashad and legal counsel plan to meet to review the proposed rule tomorrow.

Both Jack and I have requested a copy of the draft rule. CA will not release a copy until the team confers with the Mayor.

Finally, I shared the notice of default on the Thomas Circle lease with Beverly to demonstrate the real potential liability for Digi and its substantial financial exposure.

Thanks for taking the time to speak with me on the phone earlier. Per our conversation, just wanted to give everyone a quick update on things.

At the moment, we're still waiting on the judge's ruling regarding our signs. He originally said to expect his decision last Friday; however our attorneys tell us it's very common for judges to take longer than their initial timeline estimates. We will let you know as soon as a ruling comes down and once issued we expect to resume work.

On the administrative side, I've attached the letter regarding transferring the building permit over to Digi Media. When we initially filed for the permit we had it issued in your ownership's name. As I discussed with John, the transferring of the permit will allow Digi to appeal DCRA's Stop Work Order issued at your property. If you or your legal team has any questions, Digi's attorneys at Donohue & Stearns are handling the Administrative Hearing on this matter with DCRA and I've attached their contact information below.

We're trying to respond by Friday November 4th so If you're able to review, sign and return a copy by tomorrow morning or later today that would be greatly appreciated.

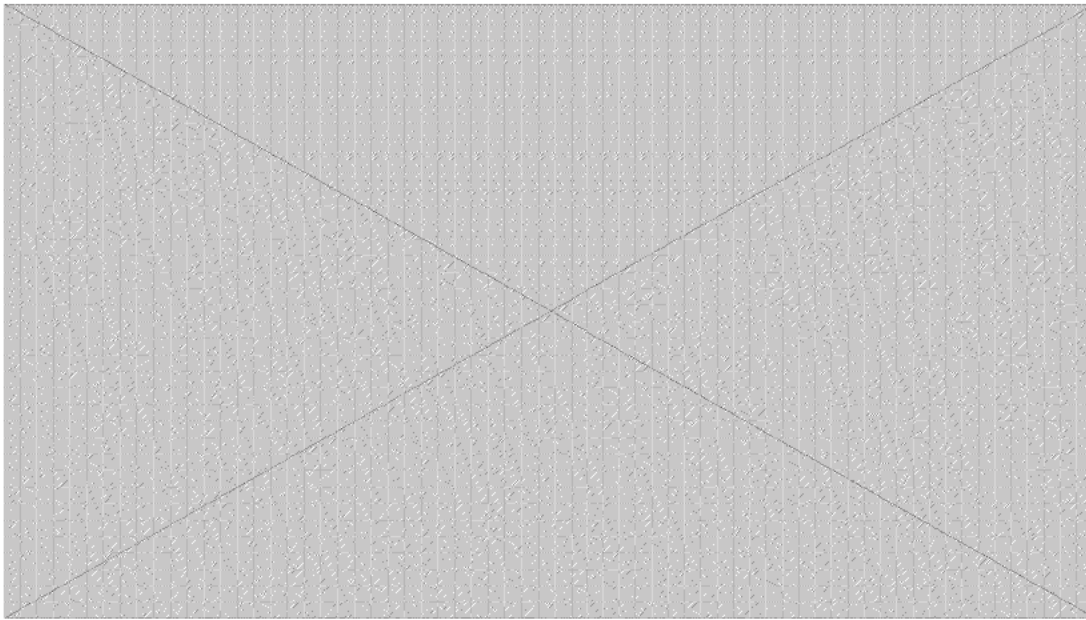
Greg,



Good morning. [REDACTED] forwarded me the link below. Please confirm you have all the required permits to perform the planned installation at the Homer Bldg. Attached is the permit you provided to us for installation of interior brackets. Did you pull other trade permits (electrical & sign) as well? I had one contractor working in the building who indicated their electrician attempted to pull their trade permit yesterday and it was denied due to a stop work order on our building. Please be sure, your permits are posted in a visible location in the area of work.

Additionally, your work started last night. Apparently the individual working was from Sands Masonry and I do not believe either [REDACTED] were present onsite. Please be sure there is a designated superintendant on site when work is being performed and that we have their contact information and they have our contact information.
