

A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To remove from the Plan of Permanent Systems of Highways a portion of 39th Street, N.W., located within Lot 801 in Square 1823 on an emergency basis, as shown on the Surveyor’s Plan filed under S.O. 18-41885.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Abandonment of the Highway Plan for 39th Street, N.W., S.O. 18-41885, Emergency Act of 2020.”

Sec. 2. Notwithstanding section 6 of An Act to provide a permanent system of highways in that part of the District of Columbia lying outside of the cities, approved June 28, 1898 (30 Stat. 520; D.C. Official Code § 9-101.06), the Council amends the permanent system of highways to remove a portion of 39th Street, N.W., located within Lot 801 in Square 1832, between Upton Street, N.W., and Rodman Street, N.W., as shown on the Surveyor’s Plat filed under S.O. 18-41885.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

33           Sec. 4. Effective date.

34           This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of a veto by  
35 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer  
36 than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in  
37 section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87  
38 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
