A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 8, 9 and 10 to Contract No. RM-17-C-050-BY4-DJW with Anchor Mental Health Association, Inc. to provide mobile response child/youth crises services and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 8, 9 and 10 to Contract No. RM-17-C-050-BY4-DJW with Anchor Mental Health Association, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2020”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. 8, 9 and 10 to Contract No. RM-17-C-050-BY4-DJW with Anchor Mental Health Association, Inc. to provide mobile response child/youth crises services, and authorizes payment in the not-to-exceed amount of \$2,312,399.40 for goods and services received and to be received under Modification Nos. 8, 9 and 10 to Contract No. RM-17-C-050-BY4-DJW.

1 Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement provided by the Chief
2 Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General
3 Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C.
4 Official Code § 1-301.47a).

5 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the
6 event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain
7 in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the
8 District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
9 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
