17 To approve, on an emergency basis, Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S and  
18 Modification No. 1 between the Department of General Services and Thiha, Inc.,  
19 increasing the Contract's aggregate not-to-exceed ("NTE") amount to \$3.5  
20 million and authorizing payment to Thiha, Inc. for goods and services received  
21 and to be received under the contract and modification.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

24 That this act may be cited as the "Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S and  
25 Modification No. 1 with Thiha, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency  
26 Act of 2020".

27 Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,  
28 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), the Council  
29 approves Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S and Modification No. 01 between the  
30 Department of General Services and Thiha, Inc. for small general construction projects,  
31 increasing the aggregate not-to-exceed ("NTE") amount of the Contract to \$3.5 million,  
32 and authorizing payment to Thiha, Inc. for goods and services received and to be received  
33 under this contract and modification.

34 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

1           The Council adopts the fiscal statement of the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal  
2 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of  
3 1975, approved October 6, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

4           Sec. 4. Effective date.

5           This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto  
6 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for  
7 no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of  
8 Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved  
9 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
