27	Prevention Second Emergency Amendment Act of 2019, enacted on November 25, 2019 (D.C.
28	Act 23-168; 66 DCR 15702), which is set to expire on February 23, 2020.
29	(b) On November 19, 2019, the Council passed the Community Harassment Prevention
30	Second Temporary Amendment Act of 2019, enacted on December 5, 2019 (D.C. Act 23-176; 66
31	DCR 16183), for which the projected law date is March 7, 2020.
32	(c) In order to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency legislation
33	and the effective date of the temporary legislation, it is now necessary to approve this congressional
34	review emergency legislation.

- Sec. 2. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Community Harassment Prevention Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2020 be adopted after a single reading.
