24	Sec. 2. (a) On October 8, 2019, the Council passed the Sanctuary Values Emergency
25	Amendment Act of 2019, effective October 23, 2019 (D.C. Act 23-131; 66 DCR 14298), which
26	expires on January 21, 2020. This emergency legislation limits the District's cooperation with
27	federal immigration agencies, including by complying with detainer requests, absent a judicial
28	warrant or order.
29	(b) On October 22, 2019, the Council passed the Sanctuary Values Temporary Amendment
30	Act of 2019, enacted on November 18, 2019 (D.C. Act 23-162; 66 DCR 15343), which is projected
31	to become law on March 3, 2020.

(c) In order to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency legislation
and the effective date of the temporary legislation, it is now necessary to approve this congressional
review emergency legislation.

35 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances 36 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the 37 Sanctuary Values Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2020 be adopted after a 38 single reading.

39 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
