A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, the reprogramming request of Fiscal Year 2020 Capital Funds in the amount of \$1,490,000 from the Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency to the Department of General Services.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Reprogramming Fiscal Year 2020 Capital Funds in the amount of \$1,490,000 from the Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency to the Department of General Services for the proposed purchase of the W Street transfer station Emergency Approval Act of 2020”.

Sec. 2. (a) Pursuant to section 47-363 of the District of Columbia Official Code, the Mayor transmitted to the Council a reprogramming request in the amount of \$1,490,000 of Fiscal Year 2020 Capital Funds to be transferred from the Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency to the Department of General Services.

(b) The Council approves the \$1,490,000 reprogramming request.

Sec. 3. Fiscal Impact Statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact prepared by the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code §1-301.47a).

Sec. 4. Effective date.

33 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
34 Mayor, action by the Council to override that veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than
35 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section
36 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;
37 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)) .
