19	RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
20	resolution may be cited as the "Reprogramming Fiscal Year 2020 Capital Funds in the amount of
21	\$1,490,000 from the Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency to the Department
22	of General Services for the proposed purchase of the W Street transfer station Emergency
23	Declaration Resolution of 2020".
24	Sec. 2. (a) The Executive submitted this reprogramming to the Council on January 29,
25	2020 in order to transfer Fiscal Year 2020 Capital Funds in the amount of \$1,490,000 from the
26	Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency to the Department of General Services.
27	These funds will be used for the proposed purchase of the W Street transfer station located on or
28	near W Street, N.E., east of Brentwood Road, N.E., Lots 36, 41, and 0802 in Square 3942 and
29	Parcels 0143/107 and 0143/110 ("W Street Site").
30	(b) The District government has a significant need for warehousing and storage for
31	equipment, records, property, and supplies. The District's need for warehousing and storage is
32	near exceeding the District's current capacity at its owned facilities and there is a reduction in the
33	supply of, and limited vacancy within, warehouse space available for lease in the District.

- (d) Acquisition of the W Street Site will allow the District to construct and operate a warehouse and storage facility at the W Street Site before the District runs out of owned space for these purposes.
- (e) Immediate Council approval of this reprogramming is necessary in order for DGS to have the available funds to acquire all lots associated with the trash transfer business via the exercise of eminent domain, for the purposes of warehousing and storage.
