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15 To amend, on an emergency basis, the District of Columbia Election Code of 1955 to provide
16 students with an excused absence of at least 2 hours to vote in person in any Board-run
17 election, or, if the student is not a District resident, in any election run by the jurisdiction
18 in which the student is registered to vote, and allow the educational institution to specify
19 the hours during which the student takes leave, including by requiring the student to take
20 leave during early voting.
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
23 act may be cited as the “Leave to Vote Emergency Amendment Act of 2020”.

24 Sec. 2. The District of Columbia Election Code of 1955, approved August 12, 1955 (69
25 Stat. 699; D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.01 *et seq.*), is amended by adding a new section 7a to
26 read as follows:

27 “Sec. 7a. Leave to vote.

28 “(a) For the purposes of this section, the term:

29 “(1) “Educational institution” means any school in the District of Columbia
30 Public Schools system, a public charter school, an independent school, a private school, a
31 parochial school, or a private instructor in the District.

32 “(2) “Student” means any person who is enrolled in an educational institution who
33 is eligible to vote.

34 “(b) Upon the request of a student, an educational institution shall provide the student an
35 excused absence of at least 2 hours to vote in person in any election held under this act, or, if the
36 student is not registered to vote in the District, in any election run by the jurisdiction in which the
37 student is registered to vote; provided, that the student’s educational institution may specify the
38 hours during which the student may take the leave, including by requiring that the student take
39 the leave during any period designated for early voting instead of on the day of the election.”.

45 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
46 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than
47 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section
48 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;
49 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
