

- D. Subject to appropriations, this paragraph serves as the Buyer's letter of intent for Fiscal Year 2021 to execute an extension pursuant to paragraph B of this section or execute a new MOU with identical terms for at least \$215,790.00.

## V. AUTHORITY FOR MOU

The authority for this MOU may be found at D.C. Official Code § 1-301.01(k). The MOU is entered into to carry out the provisions of Title 6-B, Chapters 4 and 16 of the DCMR.

## VI. FUNDING PROVISIONS

### A. Cost of Services

1. Total cost for services under this MOU shall not exceed \$215,790.00 for Fiscal Year 2020. Funding for services shall not exceed the actual cost of the goods and services.
2. The estimated cost of this MOU is based upon the projected service costs outlined on the following page. These projections are only estimates and do not account for all suitability related services that may be provided under this MOU. For example, the Buyer may request weekend service collections which may result in overtime fees. However, the total resulting service cost shall not exceed the maximum amount of this MOU established in subsection (A) (1).

### B. Payment

1. Payment for the goods and services shall be made through an Intra-District advance by the Buyer to the Seller based on the total amount of this MOU.
2. The Seller shall submit quarterly invoices that shall include the amounts billed for that period. The invoices shall include: (1) a list of services and their costs; and (2) a list of labor costs including hourly rates for all laborers.
3. The advance to the Seller for the services to be performed and goods to be provided shall not exceed the amount of this MOU.
4. The Seller shall receive the advance and bill the Buyer through the Intra-District process only for those goods and services actually provided pursuant to the terms of this MOU. The Seller shall return any excess advance to the Buyer within thirty (30) calendar days prior to the end of the current fiscal year.
5. The Parties' Directors, or their designees, shall resolve all adjustments and disputes arising from services performed under this MOU. In the event the Parties are unable to resolve a financial issue, the matter shall be referred to the Office of Financial Operations and Systems for final resolution.

## **VII. ANTI-DEFICIENCY CONSIDERATIONS**

The Parties acknowledge and agree that their respective obligations to fulfill financial obligations of any kind pursuant to any and all provisions of this MOU, or any subsequent agreement entered into by the Parties pursuant to this MOU, are and shall remain subject to the provisions of: (i) the federal Anti-Deficiency Act, 31 U.S.C. §§ 1341, 1342, 1349, 1351; (ii) the District of Columbia Anti-Deficiency Act, D.C. Official Code §§ 47-355.01-355.08; (iii) D.C. Official Code § 47-105; and (iv) D.C. Official Code § 1-204.46, as may be amended, regardless of whether a particular obligation has been expressly so conditioned.

## **VIII. COMPLIANCE AND MONITORING**

As this MOU is funded by District of Columbia funds, the Seller will be subject to scheduled and unscheduled monitoring reviews by the Buyer to ensure compliance with all applicable requirements.

## **IX. PROCUREMENT PRACTICES ACT**

If the goods and/or services of an agent, contractor, consultant or other third party will be utilized to execute the processes described in this MOU, then the Parties shall abide by the provisions of the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010 (D.C. Official Code § 2-351.01, *et seq.*) to procure those goods and/or services.

## **X. RECORDS AND REPORTS**

The Seller shall maintain records and receipts for the expenditure of all funds provided for a period of no less than three (3) years from the date of expiration or termination of this MOU and, upon request of the Buyer or another District of Columbia government agency with legal authority to request review, make these documents available for inspection by duly authorized representatives of the Buyer and other officials as may be specified by the District of Columbia.

## **XI. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION**

The Parties to this MOU will use, restrict, safeguard, and dispose of all information related to services provided by this MOU, in accordance with all relevant federal and local statutes, regulations, and policies. Information received by either Party in the performance of responsibilities associated with this MOU shall remain the property of the Buyer.

## **XII. TERMINATION**

Either Party may terminate this MOU in whole or in part by giving forty-five (45) calendar days advance written notice to the other Party. In the event of termination of this MOU, the Seller will conclude any previously-requested suitability related services and will return any unused funds after all required fiscal reconciliation, but not later than September 30<sup>th</sup> of the then current fiscal year.


### XIV. MODIFICATIONS



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between the

**DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

and the

**ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) as of this 28<sup>th</sup> day of September 2018, by and between District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) and Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS), hereafter collectively referred to as the "Parties".

WHEREAS, the Parties enter this MOU dated September 28, 2018, for DCPS to provide Title I services to eligible students attending private school in the District of Columbia who reside in Anne Arundel County, Maryland; and AACPS to provide Title I services to eligible students attending private school in Anne Arundel County, Maryland who reside in the District of Columbia.

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to enter the conditions, responsibilities, and provisions of the MOU effective September 28, 2018, and ending June 14, 2019.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties hereby set forth this MOU as follows:

### **Purpose**

This MOU creates a process for the provision of Title I educational instructional services and additional supports to certain eligible private school children who meet established eligibility and residency criteria. This agreement describes the services to be provided, the roles and responsibilities of each Party, and funding procedures. The determination of aforementioned Title I funds is pursuant to the requirements of the *Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015*.

### **Term**

The initial term of this MOU will be for the 2018-2019 school year, with an effective date of September 28, 2018 through June 14, 2019. Thereafter, the MOU may be renewed for additional one-year terms, or any fraction thereof, if both parties agree to the renewal in writing. To propose a renewal of this MOU, one party must provide notice to the other of a request for renewal at least sixty (60) days prior to the end of the current term.

### **1. Consultation: Description of Services**

- A. Decisions will be made regarding the delivery of services during the consultation meetings between the two Parties and will include the following components:
  - a. Identifying funding for student-related services based on the per pupil allocation

- b. Develop eligibility requirements for selecting students eligible to participate in the Title I program
- c. Select service delivery site
- B. The scope of services will include the following components:
  - a. The Parties will collaborate on the service delivery model adopted by each respective Local Education Agency (LEA)
  - b. The Parties will collaborate on the frequency and duration of weekly service instructional time

## 2. Assessment

- A. The assessment of services will be performed by the LEA providing and include documentation of the following:
  - a. Pre and post tests
  - b. Student progress
  - c. Attendance

## 3. Additional Support Services

- A. The support services will include the following components:
  - a. Parent involvement activities and identification available funding under Title I for this purpose
  - b. Professional development for teachers for eligible students if the school system reserves funds from the Title I allocation for the Title I professional development activities
  - c. Title I counseling, mentoring, and/or one on one services for eligible Title I students if the school system reserves funds from the Title I allocation for the additional Title I student supports

## 4. Responsibilities

- A. The Parties respective Title I offices will provide services as follows:
  - a. Designate a contact person for Title I services for eligible students attending private school(s)
  - b. Determine participating public-school attendance areas and certify the number of eligible private school students
  - c. Provide, to the extent allowable under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act or any other applicable law, and review annual data regarding eligible students who attend private schools in the other Party's jurisdiction
  - d. Provide sufficient and reliable data concerning the amount of Title I funding that is generated for services to eligible students
  - e. Reserve the required amount of Title I funds for instructional services for identified students, parent involvement activities, and professional development activities, if applicable.
  - f. Annually consult with the designated contact person to determine the scope and nature of Title I services to eligible students who attend private schools in one local school system and reside in another
  - g. Provide, to the extent allowable under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act or any other applicable law, assessment data for eligible students receiving Title I services

## 5. Transfer of Funds

By November 15<sup>th</sup>, of the current school year, the amount of Title I funding that is owed to the other Party of Title I services will be determined. An invoice for the full amount shall be submitted, accompanied by appropriate documentation for payment (listed below). This invoice must be paid within 30 days of receipt, but no later than December 15<sup>th</sup>.

- Total number of students served
- List of students by grade level and school name
- Schedule of services provided
- Name(s) of service provider(s)
- Service delivery model
- Service to students and parent involvement activities

## 6. Audit

Each party shall retain and upon request make available to the other Party, all accounts and records relating to this Agreement during the term of this Agreement and for five years after this Agreement ends. Each party has the right, upon reasonable prior written notification, to audit and inspect all accounts and records maintained by the other Party in connection with this Agreement and may do so at the other Party's normal business hours.

## 7. Civil Rights and Equal Employment Opportunity

Each party agrees that it shall not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, age, ancestry or national origin, gender, physical or mental disability, marital status, or veteran's status with respect to employment opportunity or access to the program pursuant to this Agreement.

## 8. Notices and Contact Persons

Any inquiries under this MOU shall be directed to the Parties listed below. Any notices required under this MOU shall be in writing, sent by a recognized form of communication and by any recognized delivery method agreed to by the Parties.

## 9. Anti-Deficiency Considerations

DCPS's duty to fulfill financial obligations to any kind pursuant to any and all provisions of this MOU, or any subsequent agreement entered into pursuant to this MOU, are and shall remain subject to the provisions of (i) the federal Anti-Deficiency Act, 31 U.S.C. §§ 1341, 1342, 1349-1351; (ii) the District of Columbia Anti-Deficiency Act, D.C. Official Code §§ 47-355.01-355.08 (2001); (iii) D.C. Official Code § 47-105 (2001); as the foregoing statutes may be amended from time to time, regardless of whether a particular obligation has been expressly so conditioned. Pursuant to the Anti-Deficiency Acts, nothing in this MOU shall create an obligation on DCPS in anticipation of an appropriation by Congress for such purpose, and DCPS's legal liability for any obligations under this MOU shall not arise or obtain in advance of the lawful availability of appropriated funds for the applicable fiscal year as approved by Congress.

## 10. Modifications

Modifications to this Agreement may be made only in writing signed by authorized representatives of both Parties.

## 11. Counterparts


This Agreement may be executed on one or more counterparts; each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which, taken together, shall constitute one and the same instrument.









**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN

FY 2019**

**I. INTRODUCTION**

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) is entered into by and between the District of Columbia Commission on Arts and Humanities, the buyer agency (“CAH” or “Buyer”) and the District of Columbia Public Schools, the seller agency (“DCPS” or “Seller”), collectively referred to herein as the “Parties.”

CAH requests that DCPS provide personnel and contractual services that will aid the District of Columbia (“the District”) in strengthening its delivery of study abroad and related services to students attending DCPS. DCPS will perform several program management and contract administration functions to ensure a continuum and continuity of services for student travelers throughout the District. This will allow the District to sustain the DCPS Study Abroad program and to optimize program effectiveness and efficiency.

**II. PROGRAM GOALS AND OBJECTIVES**

In 2016, the District committed to making global learning through travel equitably accessible to students by launching DCPS Study Abroad, the nation’s first fully funded K-12 global travel program. To effectuate the programs and augment services, additional funding is needed by DCPS. Through CAH’s intra-district of funds to DCPS, the agencies will guarantee the continued operation of key projects associated with joint CAH/DCPS education efforts.

**DCPS Study Abroad:** DCPS Study Abroad is the nation’s first fully funded district-wide global travel program of its size, for students at the K-12 level in a public-school system. DCPS contracts an educational travel vendor(s) that can work to tailor its programming to meet the unique needs of DCPS Study Abroad and whose staff has professionalism, expertise, and cultural competency necessary for creating positive travel experiences for diverse groups of travelers, including but not limited to travelers of color; LGBTQ+ travelers; travelers with disabilities; and first-time, first-generation travelers.

DCPS Study Abroad engages educators, students, and families in Washington, DC from August – September; travel for students and educators occurs in the summer, from June –July, with destinations in the USA and around the world, where at least one official language is Spanish, French, Mandarin, and/or Italian. All destinations which include Italian-language connections must also include either a French or Spanish connection. One domestic destination is needed for middle school travelers and one is needed for high school travelers. Domestic destinations in the USA must have global connections and be accessible via bus within nine hours from Washington,

DC. DCPS Study Abroad prefers as diverse a range of travel destinations as possible, given the program's language requirements, and aims to plan tours in Central America, South America, the Caribbean, Europe, Africa, Asia, and North America.

Approximately \$1,000,000 has been designated to support the contracting of educational travel vendor(s) for DCPS Study Abroad in School Year 2018-2019, Fiscal Year 2019.

### III. SCOPE OF SERVICES

Pursuant to applicable authorities and in furtherance of the shared goals of the Parties to carry out the purposes of this MOU expeditiously and economically, the Parties do hereby agree:

#### A. RESPONSIBILITIES OF SELLER

1. The Seller (DCPS) shall:
  - a. Serve as the lead agency for all contracts established with these funds and shall serve as the lead agency with respect to all aspects of contract administration (including but not limited to, issuing requests for proposals, selecting vendors, drafting contracts, receiving goods and services, reviewing invoices, completing performance reviews, preparing of draw down requests, and developing programmatic reports) and program management (including, but not limited to, recruiting and selecting participants, training and preparation, soliciting feedback and surveying participants, and ongoing engagement of alumni).
  - b. Once per fiscal year, the DCPS Global Education team will submit to CAH a budget-to-actual-expenditure report for review and approval by CAH, accompanied by a summary of program activities executed using the funds received by DCPS from CAH for this purpose.
  - c. Participate in meetings as needed to reconcile any disagreements between the Parties as to amounts owed under the MOU.
  - d. Provide program details as needed to satisfy internal and external data requests made to CAH regarding the progress of the initiative funded through this MOU.

#### B. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BUYER

1. The Buyer, CAH, shall make payment via intra-district advance in a total amount of One Million and 00/100 Dollars (**\$1,000,000.00**) for use in FY 2019. The primary use for these funds will be to cover educational travel vendor contracts for DCPS Study Abroad. These vendor contracts cover the management of all on-tour experiences for participating students and educators, including, but not limited to, the booking and purchase of:

- a. Roundtrip airfare for all travelers on international trips
  - b. Roundtrip private charter bus for travelers on domestic trips
  - c. Accommodations at 3-star hotels or better in shared rooms (bed-sharing not permitted)
  - d. Travel insurance for all travelers
  - e. Health insurance for all travelers
  - f. Three meals per day for every travel day for all travelers
  - g. Standard baggage fees, in the event that airlines do not automatically guarantee one free standard checked bag per traveler
  - h. Tour Director/Program Director hiring
  - i. Entrance fees, language class enrollment, tour guide fees, and other such cost associated with tour activities
  - j. Country-specific exit/entrance fees to be paid upon arrival/departure for all travelers
2. **Excess funds** from the aforementioned \$1,000,000.00 may be used by DCPS to cover ancillary expenses associated with DCPS' global education programming, including, but not limited to:
    - a. DCPS Study Abroad Student Showcase
    - b. DCPS Study Abroad Travel Ambassador training, management, and support
    - c. DCPS Study Abroad student recruitment, retention, and pre-departure preparation
    - d. DCPS Study Abroad alumni engagement
    - e. DCPS Study Abroad family and community engagement
    - f. DCPS Study Abroad student travel documentation and other material needs (i.e. suitcases, travel-sized toiletries, etc.)
  3. Review reports and financial reports submitted by the Seller.

#### IV. DURATION OF MOU

The period of this MOU shall be from October 1, 2018, through September 30, 2019, unless terminated in writing by the Parties prior to its expiration in accordance with Section X.

#### V. AUTHORITY FOR MOU

D.C. Official Code § 1-301.01(k)

#### VI. FUNDING PROVISIONS

##### A. COST OF SERVICES

1. Total cost for goods and services under this MOU shall not exceed **\$1,000,000.00** for Fiscal Year 2019. Funding for the goods and services shall not exceed the actual cost of the goods and services as outlined in **Section III. B. 1.** and **Section III. B. 2.**

2. In the event of termination of the MOU, payment to Seller shall be held in abeyance until fiscal reconciliation, but not longer than September 30 of the current fiscal year.

**B. PAYMENT**

1. All Payments for goods and services shall be made through an Intra-District advance by CAH to DCPS. DCPS shall provide CAH, on an annual basis, a budget to actual expenditure report. This report shall be reviewed by the CAH program staff before the end of the fiscal year.
2. Pursuant to the Financial Review Process ("FRP") mandated by the Office of the Chief Financial Officer of the District of Columbia, all services provided through Intra-District funding shall be reported in the Buyer Agency's FRP submission to the Office of Budget and Planning.
3. DCPS shall submit to CAH, by no later than fourteen (14) business days following the close the District's 2019 fiscal year, a full reconciliation of costs associated with this MOU. This reconciliation shall include a list of expenditures made from funds advanced by CAH to DCPS.
4. DCPS shall relieve the above-referenced advance and bill CAH through the Intra-District funding process only for those services actually provided pursuant to the terms of this MOU. Any excess advance remaining after program activities have concluded shall be returned to CAH. DCPS will notify CAH within thirty (30) calendar days before the end of the current fiscal year if it has reason to believe that all of the advance will not be billed during the current fiscal year. DCPS shall return any excess advance to CAH by September 30 of the current fiscal year.
5. CAH shall advance the lump-sum payment of \$1,000,000.00 to DCPS by October 31, 2018. CAH reserves the right to review and request supporting documentation for charges posted to the MOU Account, and to dispute charges.
6. In the event that CAH should dispute a payment, DCPS will summarize, in writing, the purpose of the payment in question and, if possible, an amount equivalent to the disputed charges should be withheld from any subsequent payments until CAH and DCPS reach an agreement on the amount owed, or as otherwise directed by the Office of the City Administrator.
7. Advances to DCPS for the services to be performed under this MOU shall not exceed the amount of this MOU.
8. Nothing in this MOU binds CAH to provide in any fiscal year additional funding to DCPS in excess of amounts appropriated under this MOU.

9. If DCPS incurs costs in excess of this MOU for services covered by this MOU, DCPS shall determine whether sufficient funds are available within its budget (GAO) to cover such excess costs.

### **C. ANTI-DEFICIENCY CONSIDERATIONS**

The Parties acknowledge and agree that their respective obligations to fulfill financial obligations of any kind pursuant to any and all provisions of this MOU, or any subsequent agreement entered into by the Parties pursuant to this MOU, are and shall remain subject to the provisions of (i) the federal Anti-Deficiency Act, 31 U.S.C. §§ 1341, 1342, 1349-1351 and 1511-1519 (2004), and D.C. Official Code §§ 1-206.03(e) and 47-105 (2001); (ii) the District of Columbia Anti-Deficiency Act, D.C. Official Code §§ 47-355.01-355.08 (2004 Supp.); and (iii) Section 446 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.46 (2001), as the foregoing statutes may be amended from time to time, regardless of whether a particular obligation has been expressly so conditioned.

### **VII. COMPLIANCE AND MONITORING**

As this MOU is funded by District of Columbia funds, Seller will be subject to scheduled and unscheduled monitoring reviews to ensure compliance with all applicable requirements.

### **VIII. RECORDS AND REPORTS**

The Seller shall maintain records and receipts for the expenditure of all funds provided for a period of no less than five (5) years from the date of expiration or termination of the MOU and, upon the District of Columbia's request, make these documents available for inspection by duly authorized representatives of the Buyer agency and other officials as may be specified by the District of Columbia at its sole discretion.

### **IX. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION**

The Parties to this MOU will use, restrict, safeguard and dispose of all information related to services provided by this MOU, in accordance with all relevant federal and local statutes, regulations, policies. Information received by either Party in the performance of responsibilities associated with the performance of this MOU shall remain the property of the respective Parties.

### **X. TERMINATION**

Either Party may terminate this MOU in whole or in part by giving thirty (30) calendar days advance written notice to the other Party. In the event of termination of this MOU, DCPS shall return any unused portion of the advance from CAH within fourteen (14) calendar days of the effective termination date, and in no case later than September 30 of the current fiscal year.

WHEREAS, the Parties enter this MOU dated September 28, 2018, for DCPS to provide Title I services to eligible students attending private school in the District of Columbia who reside in Calvert County, Maryland; and CCPS to provide Title I services to eligible students attending private school in Calvert County, Maryland who reside in the District of Columbia.

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to enter the conditions, responsibilities, and provisions of the MOU effective September 28, 2018, and ending June 14, 2019.

  - d. Provide sufficient and reliable data concerning the amount of Title I funding that is generated for services to eligible students
  - e. Reserve the required amount of Title I funds for instructional services for identified students, parent involvement activities, and professional development activities, if applicable.
  - f. Annually consult with the designated contact person to determine the scope and nature of Title I services to eligible students who attend private schools in one local school system and reside in another
  - g. Provide, to the extent allowable under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act or any other applicable law, assessment data for eligible students receiving Title I services

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

between the

**DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

and the

**PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) as of this 28<sup>th</sup> day of September 2018, by and between District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) and Prince George's County Public Schools (PGCPS), hereafter collectively referred to as the "Parties".

WHEREAS, the Parties enter this MOU dated September 28, 2018, for DCPS to provide Title I services to eligible students attending private school in the District of Columbia who reside in Prince George's County, Maryland; and PGCPS to provide Title I services to eligible students attending private school in Prince George's County, Maryland who reside in the District of Columbia.

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to enter the conditions, responsibilities, and provisions of the MOU effective September 28, 2018, and ending June 14, 2019.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties hereby set forth this MOU as follows:

**Purpose**

This MOU creates a process for the provision of Title I educational instructional services and additional supports to certain eligible private school children who meet established eligibility and residency criteria. This agreement describes the services to be provided, the roles and responsibilities of each Party, and funding procedures. The determination of aforementioned Title I funds is pursuant to the requirements of the *Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015*.

**Term**

The initial term of this MOU will be for the 2018-2019 school year, with an effective date of September 28, 2018 through June 14, 2019. Thereafter, the MOU may be renewed for additional one-year terms, or any fraction thereof, if both parties agree to the renewal in writing. To propose a renewal of this MOU, one party must provide notice to the other of a request for renewal at least sixty (60) days prior to the end of the current term.

**1. Consultation: Description of Services**

- A. Decisions will be made regarding the delivery of services during the consultation meetings between the two Parties and will include the following components:
  - a. Identifying funding for student-related services based on the per pupil allocation

- b. Develop eligibility requirements for selecting students eligible to participate in the Title I program
- c. Select service delivery site
- B. The scope of services will include the following components:
  - a. The Parties will collaborate on the service delivery model adopted by each respective Local Education Agency (LEA)
  - b. The Parties will collaborate on the frequency and duration of weekly service instructional time

## 2. Assessment

- A. The assessment of services will be performed by the LEA providing and include documentation of the following:
  - a. Pre and post tests
  - b. Student progress
  - c. Attendance

## 3. Additional Support Services

- A. The support services will include the following components:
  - a. Parent involvement activities and identification available funding under Title I for this purpose
  - b. Professional development for teachers for eligible students if the school system reserves funds from the Title I allocation for the Title I professional development activities
  - c. Title I counseling, mentoring, and/or one on one services for eligible Title I students if the school system reserves funds from the Title I allocation for the additional Title I student supports

## 4. Responsibilities

- A. The Parties respective Title I offices will provide services as follows:
  - a. Designate a contact person for Title I services for eligible students attending private school(s)
  - b. Determine participating public-school attendance areas and certify the number of eligible private school students
  - c. Provide, to the extent allowable under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act or any other applicable law, and review annual data regarding eligible students who attend private schools in the other Party's jurisdiction
  - d. Provide sufficient and reliable data concerning the amount of Title I funding that is generated for services to eligible students
  - e. Reserve the required amount of Title I funds for instructional services for identified students, parent involvement activities, and professional development activities, if applicable.
  - f. Annually consult with the designated contact person to determine the scope and nature of Title I services to eligible students who attend private schools in one local school system and reside in another
  - g. Provide, to the extent allowable under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act or any other applicable law, assessment data for eligible students receiving Title I services

## 5. Transfer of Funds

By November 15<sup>th</sup>, of the current school year, the amount of Title I funding that is owed to the other Party of Title I services will be determined. An invoice for the full amount shall be submitted, accompanied by appropriate documentation for payment (listed below). This invoice must be paid within 30 days of receipt, but no later than December 15<sup>th</sup>.

- Total number of students served
- List of students by grade level and school name
- Schedule of services provided
- Name(s) of service provider(s)
- Service delivery model
- Service to students and parent involvement activities

## 6. Audit

Each party shall retain and upon request make available to the other Party, all accounts and records relating to this Agreement during the term of this Agreement and for five years after this Agreement ends. Each party has the right, upon reasonable prior written notification, to audit and inspect all accounts and records maintained by the other Party in connection with this Agreement and may do so at the other Party's normal business hours.

## 7. Civil Rights and Equal Employment Opportunity

Each party agrees that is shall not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, age, ancestry or national origin, gender, physical or mental disability, marital status, or veteran's status with respect to employment opportunity or access to the program pursuant to this Agreement.

## 8. Notices and Contact Persons

Any inquiries under this MOU shall be directed to the Parties listed below. Any notices required under this MOU shall be in writing, sent by a recognized form of communication and by any recognized delivery method agreed to by the Parties.

**9. Anti-Deficiency Considerations**

DCPS's duty to fulfill financial obligations to any kind pursuant to any and all provisions of this MOU, or any subsequent agreement entered into pursuant to this MOU, are and shall remain subject to the provisions of (i) the federal Anti-Deficiency Act, 31 U.S.C. §§ 1341, 1342, 1349-1351; (ii) the District of Columbia Anti-Deficiency Act, D.C. Official Code §§ 47-355.01-355.08 (2001); (iii) D.C. Official Code § 47-105 (2001); as the foregoing statutes may be amended from time to time, regardless of whether a particular obligation has been expressly so conditioned. Pursuant to the Anti-Deficiency Acts, nothing in this MOU shall create an obligation on DCPS in anticipation of an appropriation by Congress for such purpose, and DCPS's legal liability for any obligations under this MOU shall not arise or obtain in advance of the lawful availability of appropriated funds for the applicable fiscal year as approved by Congress.

Likewise, any financial obligation of the Board of Education for Prince George's County Public Schools set forth in this MOU is subject to and contingent on the allocation of funds approved by the local Board and State Boards of Education for the State of Maryland. Any funding deficiency which accrues under the terms of this MOU that is due to a lack of appropriated funds shall not impose liability of PGCPS.

**10. Modifications**

Modifications to this Agreement may be made only in writing signed by authorized representatives of both Parties.


**11. Counterparts**

This Agreement may be executed on one or more counterparts; each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which, taken together, shall constitute one and the same instrument.




