21	effective March 5, 1981 (D.C. Law 3-149; D.C. Official Code § 7-2304.01(d)), as amended by the
22	COVID-19 Supplemental Corrections Emergency Amendment Act of 2020 is amended as follows:
23	(a) Strike the phrase "volunteer, or District government contractor" and insert the phrase
24	"volunteer, donor, or District government contractor" in its place.
25	(b) Strike the phrase "purpose, contractual or voluntary service" and insert the phrase
26	"purpose, contractual or voluntary service, or donation" in its place.
27	Sec. 3. Applicability.
28	This act shall apply as of March 11, 2020.
29	Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.
30	The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact
31	statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved
32	October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).
33	Sec. 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
