16	amend the Firearms Control Regulations Act of 1975 to prohibit the issuance of a
17	registration certificate for ghost guns, and to prohibit the sale or transfer of ghost guns; to
18	amend An Act To control the possession, sale, transfer, and use of pistols and other
19	dangerous weapons in the District of Columbia, to provide penalties, to prescribe rules of
20	evidence, and for other purposes to prohibit the possession of ghost guns; to amend the
21 22	Firearms Safety Omnibus Clarification Emergency Amendment Act of 2020 to provide that it shall apply as of April 23, 2020; and to amend the Firearms Safety Omnibus
23	Clarification Temporary Amendment Act of 2020 to clarify that it is subject to a 60-day

26	RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
27	resolution may be cited as the "Ghost Guns Prohibition Congressional Review Emergency
28	Declaration Resolution of 2020".
29	Sec. 2. (a) On March 3, 2020, the Council passed the Ghost Guns Prohibition Emergency
30	Amendment Act of 2020, effective March 11, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-245; 67 DCR 3086) ("emergency
31	act"), which expires on June 9, 2020.
32	(b) On March 17, 2020, the Council passed the Ghost Guns Prohibition Temporary
33	Amendment Act of 2020, enacted on March 31, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-276; 67 DCR 3945)
34	("temporary act"), which is undergoing congressional review and is projected to take effect August
35	1, 2020.

- (c) This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.
- Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Ghost Guns Prohibition Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2020 be adopted after a single reading.
- Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
