(a) On March 11, 2020, the Mayor of the District of Columbia issued Mayor's 25 20 Order 2020-45 and 2020-46, declaring a public emergency and a public health emergency in the 21 District due to the imminent threat to the health, safety, and welfare of District residents posed 22 by the spread of COVID-19. That order is currently in effect through April 30, 2020. (b) Residents will continue to be effected after the declared crisis and need time to 23 24 recover. 25 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances 26 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the D.C. 27 Foreclosure Prohibition During Declared Public Health Crisis Emergency Act of 2020 to be 28 adopted after a single reading.
