RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, that this resolution may be cited as "Modification Nos. 005 and 006 to Contract No. DCAM-15-CS-0097I with Kramer Consulting Services, PC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2020." Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. 005 and 006 to Contract No, DCAM-15-CS-0097I (the "Contract") between the District's Department of General Services and Kramer Consulting Services, PC ("Contractor") to increase the Contract's Option Year #004 aggregate not-to-exceed ("NTE") value to \$2,500,000.00, and to authorize payment to the Contractor for construction management services received and to be received under these modifications.

- 1 (b) Proposed Modification Nos. 005 and 006 would increase the Contract's
- 2 aggregate NTE value by \$1,550,000.00, from \$950,000.00 to \$2.500,000.00.
- 3 (c) The proposed increase is in excess of \$1 million during a 12-month period.
- 4 Council approval of Modification Nos. 005 and 006 is therefore required pursuant to
- 5 section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973
- 6 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and the requirements of section 202 of the
- 7 Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371;
- 8 D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02).
- 9 (d) Council approval of Modification Nos. 005 and 006 is necessary to allow the
- 10 continuation of essential small general construction services, as awarded via
- 11 competitively-awarded task order agreements at lump sum prices, at various District-
- owned or -operated public schools, parks and recreation facilities, and other municipal
- facilities, and to compensate the Contractor for services provided and to be provided
- 14 during Option Year #004.
- 15 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
- circumstances enumerated in Section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
- 17 necessary that the "Modification Nos. 005 and 006 with Kramer Consulting Services, PC
- Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2020" be adopted after a single
- 19 reading.
