A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-IFB-0010, between the Department of General Services and Dissen & Juhn, LLC, increasing the aggregate not-to-exceed amount of the Contract to \$1,013,562.00 and authorizing payment to Dissen & Juhn, LLC for goods and services received and to be received under the Contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, that this resolution may be cited as the “Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-IFB-0010 with Dissen & Juhn, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2020.”

Sec. 2.(a) There exists an immediate need to approve the Contract for Construction Services for MPD/FEMS Harbor Patrol Floating Shed & T-Dock System (DCAM-19-CS-IFB-0010) (the “Contract”) between the Department of General Services (the “Department”) and Dissen & Juhn, LLC (the “Contractor”) which would increase the aggregate not-to-exceed (“NTE”) amount of the Contract to \$1,013,562.00 and authorize payment to the Contractor for goods and services received and to be received under the Contract.

1 (b) The Department executed a Letter Contract in the initial not-to-exceed
2 amount of \$718,936.00.00. The amount of the Letter Contract was less than \$1 million;
3 thus, it did not require Council approval.

4 (c) The proposed Contract's aggregate amount would increase by \$294,626.00,
5 from \$718,936.00 to \$1,013,562.00. The proposed Contract is in excess of \$1 million
6 during a 12-month period; therefore, Council approval is required pursuant to section 451
7 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803;
8 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51).

9 (d) In addition, Council approval of the proposed Contract is necessary to
10 authorize the continuation of construction services associated with the MPD/FEMS
11 Harbor Patrol Floating Shed & T-Dock System and compensate the Contractor for
12 services provided and to be provided under the proposed Contract.

13 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
14 circumstances enumerated in Section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
15 necessary that the "Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-IFB-0010 with Dissen & Juhn, LLC
16 Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2020" be adopted after a single
17 reading.

18 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
